A carer is someone who provides unpaid support to family or friends who could not manage without help. This could be due to illness, mental illhealth, disability, or a substance misuse problem.

A carer can be any age and you can become a carer without being aware of it. Carers are family members, friends or neighbours who, sometimes suddenly, sometimes gradually, find themselves offering support and simply get on with what needs to be done.
